BEGINNERS Sailing Lessons: 0830 to 1130 (Mornings, M-F, your choice of six weeklong sessions) Ages 8 and up. Students are those who have never sailed before or have had basic sailing lessons. Students will learn how to maneuver a boat in all points of sail, dock, tie knots. This class may be appropriate for students who have taken Beginner Sailing Lessons before, especially younger students.

INTERMEDIATE Sailing Lessons: 1230 to 1530 (Afternoons, M-F, your choice of six weeklong sessions)
For students who have had formal sailing lessons. These students should have all the basics of sailing down such as tacking and jibing, sailing upwind. This course is designed to build confidence, improve sailing skills and boat handling and safety. Some basics of racing will be introduced.



ADVANCED Sailing Lessons: Contact Charlie Manning for Schedule (held for a one week session, evenings in July)
The focus of this class is racing. Students should be interested in participating in major Youth Sailing events in our area – Kaszube Cup at South Shore Yacht Club in Milwaukee, July 7-8.
